Unnecessary injury	Children & Adults	1	5	Medium 5	Ensure that no one with a history of back or neck problems or who suffers from a heart complaint uses the inflatable. Anyone who is feeling unwell or suffering the effects of alcohol or drugs or pregnant may not use this equipment at any time.	Remind responsible adult after set up about their responsibilities and get them to sign and date a handover form.
Overloading or tipping	Children	1	4	Medium - 4	Ensure no user weighing over 90kg or 5.9" in height uses the inflatable.	Height restrictions are reminded on a health and safety board next to the bouncy castle.
Larger participants colliding with smaller participants.	Children	1	5	Medium – 5	Remind the hirer or the suitable number of children/adults using the inflatable at the same time for safe use.	Remind responsible adult after set up about their responsibilities and get them to sign and date a handover form.

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Injury from inflatable deflation or suffocation.	Children & Adults	1	5	Medium - 5	Do not allow anyone to be on the inflatable during inflation or deflation as this can be EXTREMELY DANGEROUS.	Remind responsible adult after set up about their responsibilities and get them to sign and date a handover form. Check the condition of all potentially breakable items and ensure these are safe to provide for the hire period.
Injury from falling from height	Children & Adults	1	5	Medium - 5	Climbing, hanging or sitting on walls is DANGEROUS and must not be allowed at any time. Equipment must always be supervised this is of exceptional important when the inflatable is erected on hard surfaces.	
Injury from 3 rd party items/bodies	Children & Adults	1	4	Medium - 4	All shoes, glasses, jewellery, badges etc MUST be removed before using this inflatable. Always ensure the area surrounding the inflatable is not statement for additional guidance.	

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Chocking	Children & Adults	1	4	Medium - 4	No food, drinks or chewing gum to be allowed on or near the inflatable.	Remind hirer or responsibilities in handover form.
Injury from unsafe equipment	Children & Adults	1	4	Medium - 4	All bouncy castles are PIPA registered annually and manufactured to the highest standards and fully compliant to the very latest British and European regulations.
